

CHARMING ARROWTOWN IS A "MUST-DO" WHEN VISITING QUEENSTOWN.

Arrowtown is a quaint heritage village enveloped by beautiful mountain scenery – only 20 minutes from Queenstown.

Its standout is its famous high street. This is a lovely string of historic buildings, which opens to a tree-lined avenue sheltering one of New Zealand's most photographed sites – a delightful row of nineteenth century miners' cottages.

The pretty town sprang from the 1860s rush for the fabulous Arrow River's gold. Today it is the centre of an equally fabulous network of cycling and walking trails, scenic lookouts, and golf courses.

While Arrowtown is "snapshot heaven", it is not a gingerbread re-creation. It is a working village, alive with cafés, shops, bars, art galleries and people soaking up the feel of a special place.

A LUCKY START

It was "Maori Jack" Tewa, a shearer, who found gold in the Arrow River in 1862. But – as is the way – a pushier European, William Fox, made bigger waves, and the town started life called "Fox's". Fifteen hundred miners worked the river below the emerging Buckingham Street township. Many were Chinese, who built a separate village still viewable today.

As gold ran out, the town became a fading rural backwater. With no pressure to replace the old, it kept its heritage heart, so more than 70 historic sites remain. Its resurgence as a holiday place began in the 1950s, and luckily the importance of the town's picturesque old buildings was understood. Arrowtown was 2023 winner the most beautiful small town.

1 THE MUSEUM & HERITAGE TOWN

The essential first stop in Arrowtown is The Lakes District Museum and Information Centre, regarded as one of New Zealand's best small museums. It is your starting point for maps, bookings, and any other help you need to enjoy your visit. Inside the museum the extensive exhibition showcases the development of a fledgling gold rush town to the modern tourist destination of today, with plenty of interactive displays to intrigue adults and amuse children. Alternatively hire a gold pan and head down to the river to try your luck!

The Information Centre also hosts a book and gift shop with a wide range of New Zealand travel, culture, history and children's books, as well as high quality crafts, gifts and jewellery to take home as treasured souvenirs of your visit.

The Gallery is free to enter and showcases a diverse range of exhibitions by renowned local and national artists, with many desirable pieces displayed and available for purchase.



OUR HERITAGE TOWN

Since 1862 Arrowtown has been building its rich history and around every corner there is something new to discover. From Arrowtown's oldest remaining building from 1863, the unassuming but now iconic wooden police hut, to shops, banks and homes built in local schist stone from the 1870s.

Buckingham Street is memorable. Voted New Zealand's Most Beautiful Main Street, here you can wander past its historic buildings, imagining a scene which has remained largely unchanged since the 1880s; browse, relax or indulge amongst the irresistible charm.

Amongst the vibrant and modern commercial town centre you will notice the first buildings that helped establish this ramshackle miners camp as a town, from Pritchard's General Store, now the Pharmacy, to Athenaeum Hall, Arrowtown's historic Post Office and Postmasters House next door. Across the street, you cannot miss the old Bank of New Zealand, now home to the Lakes District Museum, a reminder that Arrowtown was founded on the discovery of gold, and lots of it! As you stroll, be sure not to miss the laneway's which open up into courtyards behind, with even more shops and eateries to discover.

Beyond the main stretch of Buckingham Street is the historic Avenue of Trees, planted in 1867 which now tower over the famous row of wooden Miners Cottages which today house, café's, shops and businesses. Go a little further and you can find Arrowtown Gaol [Jail] from 1876, one of the few

remaining gold mining era gaols in the country. You will need to borrow a key from the Lakes District Museum to look inside

Ramshaw Lane runs parallel to Buckingham Street and looks down towards the Arrow River. Once a service Lane for the shops and businesses of Buckingham Street, it is now a shopping and eating parade, with more delights to be discovered. Look closely and see the original Grocery Stores Stone Storehouse from 1870. Then head down to the water's edge, where Bush Creek trickles along with the Arrow River just beyond. Find X-Marks The Spot which marks out where the feverish rush for gold began.

Butler's Green and Dudley's Precinct, is another pocket of discovery where Arrowtown's original Police Hut can be found, close to historic Dudley's Cottage. A little further and you will find Arrowtown's renowned Chinese Settlement, free to explore, where you will learn of the lives of Arrowtown's early Chinese community, who worked alongside their European counterparts in the gold rush era but were required to live in a separate part of town.

Venture a little wider beyond Arrowtown's main street and discover its Historic Churches and the unlikely connection with Catholic Saint Mary MacKillop and her time spent in Arrowtown. On the very edge of town beside the cemetery is Soldiers Hill and Cenotaph, which offers a moment for reflection and wonderful views back towards Arrowtown.



2 ARTS & GALLERIES

Look a little closer and you will find a wide range of galleries featuring art and sculpture. Hidden up laneways or in converted churches and sheds, they are there for you to discover and many have the artists crafting on site. Contemporary works by local and international talent highlight Arrowtown's vibrant and diverse art scene. Whether you're a seasoned collector or simply an admirer of creativity, exploring Arrowtown's galleries promises a journey of artistic discovery.

3 DESTINATION SHOPPING

Arrowtown is a popular destination for boutique shopping. Most shops are independently owned and operated, with carefully curated selections of clothes, gifts, crafts, books, wines and curiosities. Speciality designer and leisure wear is available, alongside outdoor adventure clothing and merino knitwear. Gift and speciality craft shops offer plenty of ideas

for presents or souvenirs, as well as, artisan jewellery, finely crafted pounamu and, of course, gold! Finally shop and sample wines from across the region before deciding on your favourite drop to take home.

4 EAT & DRINK

Arrowtown is home to an extensive number of restaurants, pubs and bars, competing with Queenstown for some of the best places to dine in the district. From locals favourites and family friendly establishments to respected fine dining spots. Each venue offers its own unique atmosphere with global cuisine and fusion dishes crafted by talented chefs. Delicious breakfast and brunch cafes transform at night to offer "trust the chef" tasting menus, with something unique and different every time. Serious foodies, pub grub aficionados and pie shop patrons are sure to go home smiling.



5 THE CHINESE SETTLEMENT



As the initial gold rush subsided in the late 1860s the New Zealand Government invited Chinese miners to help support the economy but as their numbers grew relations became more strained. They were consigned away from the European settlement on Buckingham Street to the colder shadows of Bush Creek. However, collaboration and trade still flourished and the Chinese contributed greatly to the development of the town. The remains of the village were restored in the 1980's and the area has been a popular attraction ever since, now a nationally recognised Tohu Whenua site.

6 MORE TO EXPLORE

Arrowtown is so much more than a day trip or stop off. If you've enjoyed breakfast or lunch, then you might as well join us for dinner. Arrowtown transforms at night to reveal a whole new side to explore. As our retail scene closes for the day, our **historic buildings** are illuminated with colourful light and the evening crowd descends as our bars and laneways come alive. Our restaurants offer **alfresco dining**


in the summer or cosy wood fires in winter. **Live music** can often be heard wafting over the roof tops as you edge closer to discover where the latest local talent is playing.

Or discover the **boutique cinema** down the laneway offering artisan and mainstream movies that can be enjoyed over wine and a cheese board or hot chocolate and popcorn.

The Autumn Festival arrives to mark the end of the summer season as Arrowtown becomes famously ablaze with colour. Rich golds and reds transform the hill faces around, as well as the mature heritage trees which line our streets. Autumn is a very special time indeed as the environment and locals put on quite the show.

In winter, the mountain's snow-capped peaks arrive and the districts multiple slopes come alive with skiers and boarders to enjoy our crystal-clear blue-sky days. Arrowtown then becomes the **Après ski destination** of choice and a great place to take a rest and explore from long days up the mountain. Mulled wine and log fires await as you emerge from the frosty air.

So, however you choose to enjoy this special place, we are here to welcome you and offer something memorable for everyone to enjoy.



Here in Arrowtown we're doing all we can to protect, restore and enhance the stunning landscapes that surround us. We pride ourselves on being good stewards of the environment.


The natural environment has been heavily modified by humans over hundreds of years, but now residents, businesses and landowners are working together to restore it. And they're doing it in a way that balances expanding biodiversity with retaining the features that make Arrowtown special.

The Arrowtown Choppers and the Arrowtown Wilding Group have removed thousands of exotic trees that were taking over the hillsides, and planting non-invasive species that do well in difficult locations and give a display of colour in autumn. Volunteers from the Whakatipu Reforestation Trust have been planting natives to create wildlife corridors that attract native birds and insects, using seedlings from their nursery at Kelvin Heights.

Predator Free Arrowtown's trapping programme aims to eradicate pest species like weasels, stoats, possums and rats. Their traplines extend high into the mountains to create a sanctuary for native creatures in and around Arrowtown.



Arrowtown is also working towards SUC-free status, which will mean that we send no single-use cups to landfill. Instead coffee and tea drinkers are encouraged to sit at the café, bring their own or take it away in a reusable cup. Please look for the logo in participating cafés and restaurants.

WALKING

You can enjoy leisurely walks around the Chinese Settlement and Bush Creek or take the longer 4km loop circuit along the stunning Millenium Trail beside the Arrow River.
